Love never is envious nor boils over with jealousy,

Love is not boastful or vainglorious; Love does not display itself haughtily.

Love is not conceited (arrogant and inflated with pride);

Love is not rude (unmannerly) and does not act unbecomingly.

Love (God's Love in us) does not insist on its own rights or its own way,

for Love is not self-seeking.

Love is not touchy, fretful, or resentful. Love takes no account of the evil done to it

(Love pays no attention to a suffered wrong.)

Love does not rejoice at injustice and unrighteousness,

but rejoices when right and truth prevail.

Love bears up under anything and everything that comes.

Love is ever ready to believe the best of every person, its hopes are fadeless under all circumstances, and Love endures everything (without weakening).

Love never fails (never fades out or becomes obsolete or comes to an end).
